# Real or Fake? Spider Chart Detective Task

Item I'm Investigating:	i.e. Coin, Painting, Jewellery
Your Task: You're a detective! You need to decide if something is real or fake by looking for clues.	
Step I: What are the clues?  Write down 5 or 6 things you can look at to help you decide if the item is real.  For example:	
<ul><li>Is it very old, what makes you think it is old?</li></ul>	

- Is there a signature, or a marking?
- What is it made from?
- Does it match other real ones?
- Where did it come from


## **Step 2: Make Your Spider Chart!**

#### **Instructions:**

- I. Use the chart below.
- 2. Write one clue at the end of each leg.
- 3. Colour in each leg to show how strong the clue is.
  - Closer to the outside = strong clue
  - Closer to the middle = weak or missing clue

TIP: You can draw this with a pencil and ruler or use graph paper. Make a small circle in the centre and draw 5 or 6 legs like a star/snowflake.
