

12 Times Tables Practice Instructions

Step 1

Say the 12 times table out loud, Say it three times. Try to do it without looking by the third round!

$$\begin{aligned}1 \times 12 &= 12 \\2 \times 12 &= 24 \\3 \times 12 &= 36 \\4 \times 12 &= 48 \\5 \times 12 &= 60 \\6 \times 12 &= 72 \\7 \times 12 &= 84 \\8 \times 12 &= 96 \\9 \times 12 &= 108 \\10 \times 12 &= 120 \\11 \times 12 &= 132 \\12 \times 12 &= 144\end{aligned}$$

Step 2

Write it out, on a piece of paper.

Write the 12 times table from 1×12 to 12×12 .

Do this two times to help your brain remember.

Step 3

Quick-Fire Quiz, in pairs, take it in turns to ask random 12 times table questions, like:


What's 4×12 ?
